# **Environmental Policy**

#### **OVERVIEW**

BenevolentAI (the "Company") and its subsidiaries (together, the "Group", "we", "us" or "our") are committed to conducting its business in compliance with all relevant environmental legislation, and ensuring strong environmental governance. We are committed to protecting the environment and the responsible management of our environmental impacts across our operations.

#### SCOPE

This Policy applies to all individuals working for a Group company including all officers and employees (whether temporary or permanent) and whether on part-time or fixed-term contracts. All third-party partners, suppliers, outsourced providers and appointed representatives of any Group company should have regard to the Policy, [and are required to conduct themselves in a manner that is consistent with the requirements of this Policy].

Management at all levels are responsible for ensuring that those reporting to them are made aware of and understand this policy. Every employee is responsible for ensuring they act in accordance with this policy.
